Qualified Cycling Coaches will give you a great workout and 'keep it real', by having fun, challenging, and best of all giving you the edge on the competition when the hockey season arrives.

## Stage #1 April (\$90)

- 1. Learn the basics of road cycling
- 2. The focus will be on general fitness improvement
- 3. Basic bike maintenance / gear selection / nutrition / fun / indoor racing
- 4 weeks
- 8 sessions
- 1hr per session
- Bike supplied
- Computrainers

## Stage #2 May (\$120)

- 1. At completion riders will be NCCH certified to ride safely on local roads
- 2. Bike skills acquisition
- 3. Understanding of road traffic rules
- 4 weeks
- 8 sessions
- 1hr sessions
- Road Bike supplied
- 1 session indoors & 1 outdoors per week

## Stage #3 June (\$130)

- 1. At Completion riders will be understand racing strategies
- 2. Echelon riding / advanced bike handling and safety skills
- 3. The opportunity to enter some competitions
- 4 weeks
- 8 sessions
- 1.5hr sessions
- Road Bike supplied
- All sessions outdoors

Course Fees Stage#1 \$90 Stage #2 \$120 Stage #3 \$130

<u>Twin</u> – Stage #1&2 = \$180

<u>Combo</u> – Stage #1/2/3 = \$300

- There will be a Maximum 15 riders per Group, so that you receive quality coaching
- There is a Sibling discount of 25% for 2<sup>nd</sup>, and subsequent family members
- Road bikes will be quality Carbon ARGON 18 road racing bikes
- There will be an option to join a Squad within NCCH if you wish to continue training up until the start of the Hockey season and beyond
- Other sessions will be available if you wish to do more than 2 sessions per week
